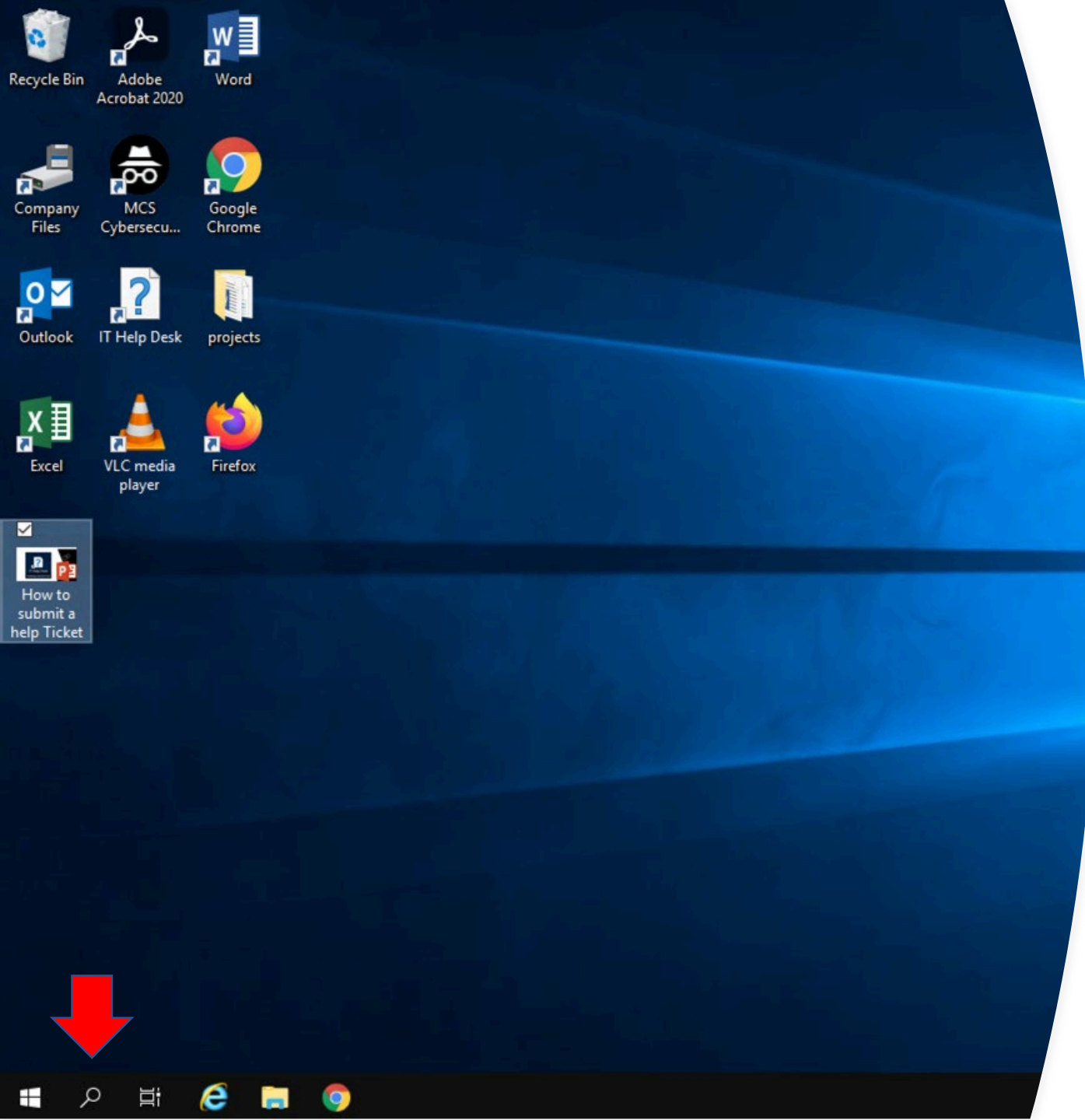


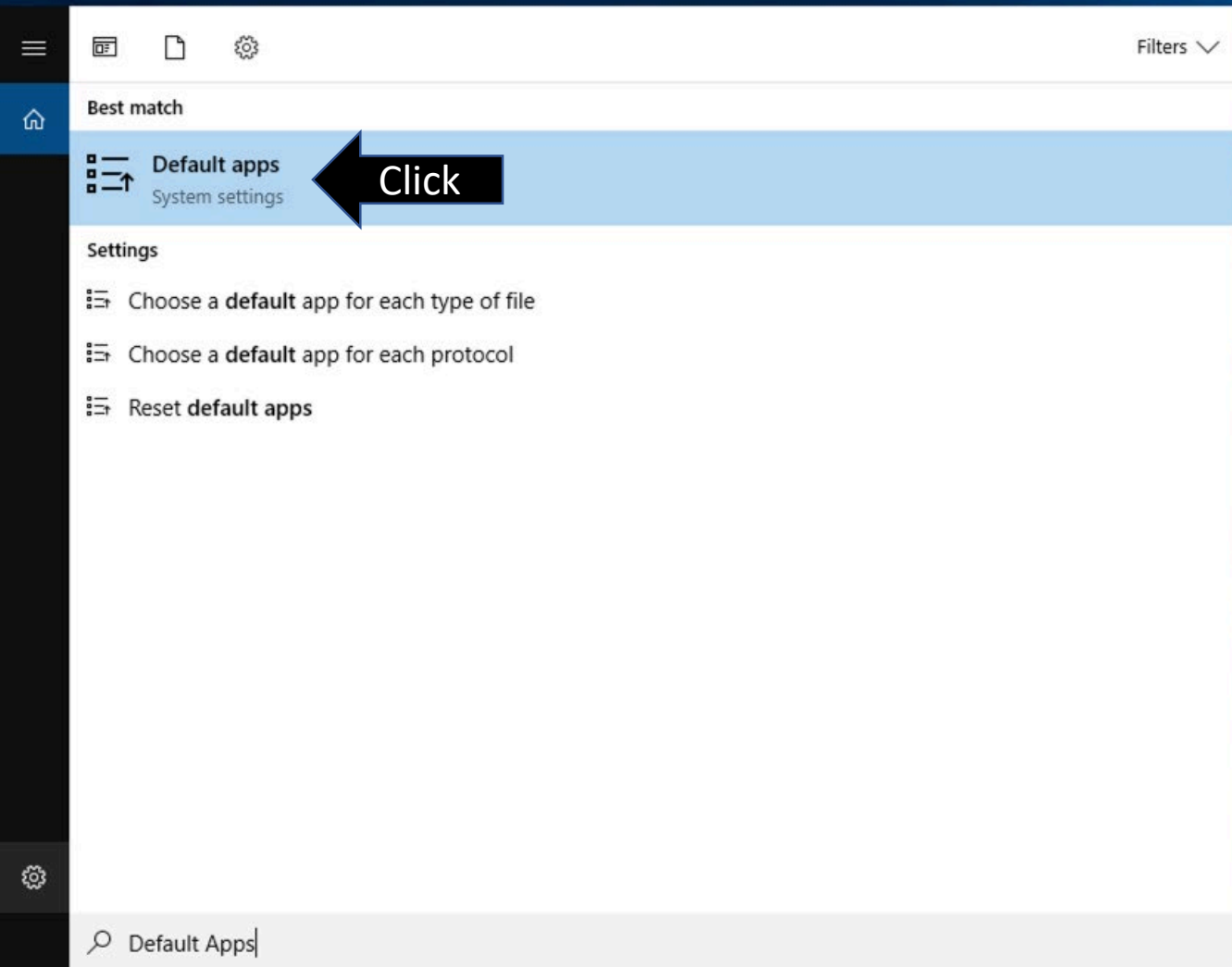


Changing your default Internet Settings





On your Desktop Click on the little magnifying glass in the bottom left corner.

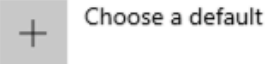


Type in "Default apps" in the search bar and click on the system setting.

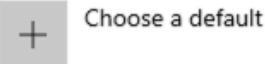

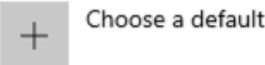
