## MASSHEALTH REDETERMINATIONS

Beginning April 1, 2023, MassHealth will reinstitute their annual eligibility renewal process which was on hold during the COVID-19 pandemic. The renewal process will last from mid-March 2023 to June 2024. #### **HELPFUL INFORMATION**

MassHealth will automatically process renewals by matching information with state and federal data. If a member's renewal cannot be automatically processed, they will receive a blue envelope in the mail with a renewal form to complete and return to MassHealth. Renew with your MA Login account, by phone, or by mail and fax.

To submit by mail or fax: (Review the renewal form included in the packet. Make any updates as needed, date and sign, and then return to the MassHealth Insurance Processing Center by mail or fax.)

### Medically Complex Respite Program


SUCCESS We are incredibly excited to announce that the Medically Complex Program (Family Bridges) offers a day
