Summer Camps for Adults with Disabilities

We are thrilled to tell you about an opportunity for a camp experience for adults 18 years and older. Grotonwood is a privately owned Christian camp in Groton, MA. They have been in existence since 1953 and offer programs ranging from minivacation weekends to weeks-long retreats with staffing ratios of 4:1, 2:1 and 1:1. Different camp sessions are designed to accommodate campers of all abilities including those who are medically fragile and require 1:1 hands-on assistance with all ADLs. Additionally, MCS is pleased to announce that we will be offering a limited number of scholarships to supplement and/ or pay for camp attendance.
