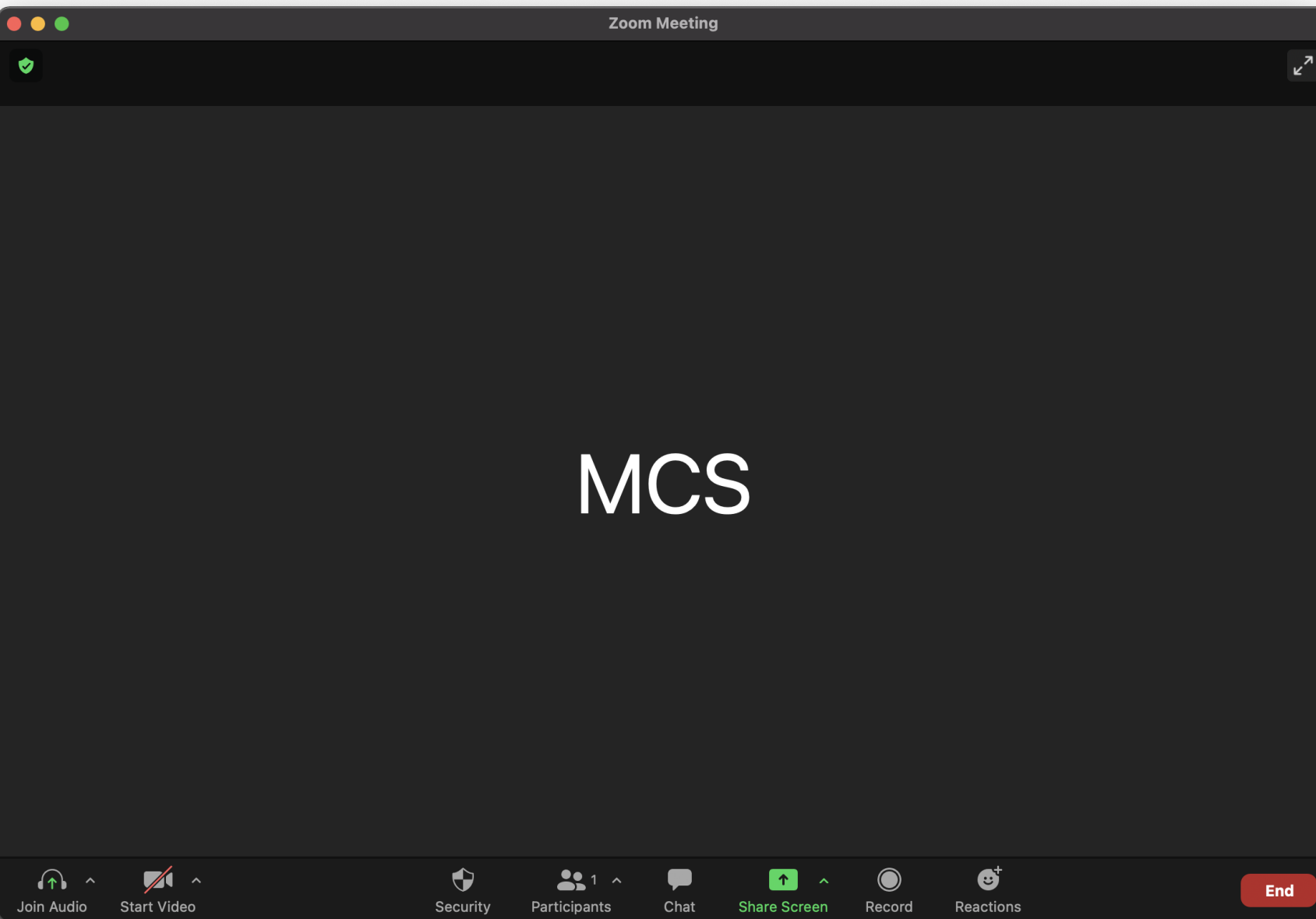

Operating Audio and Video in Zoom

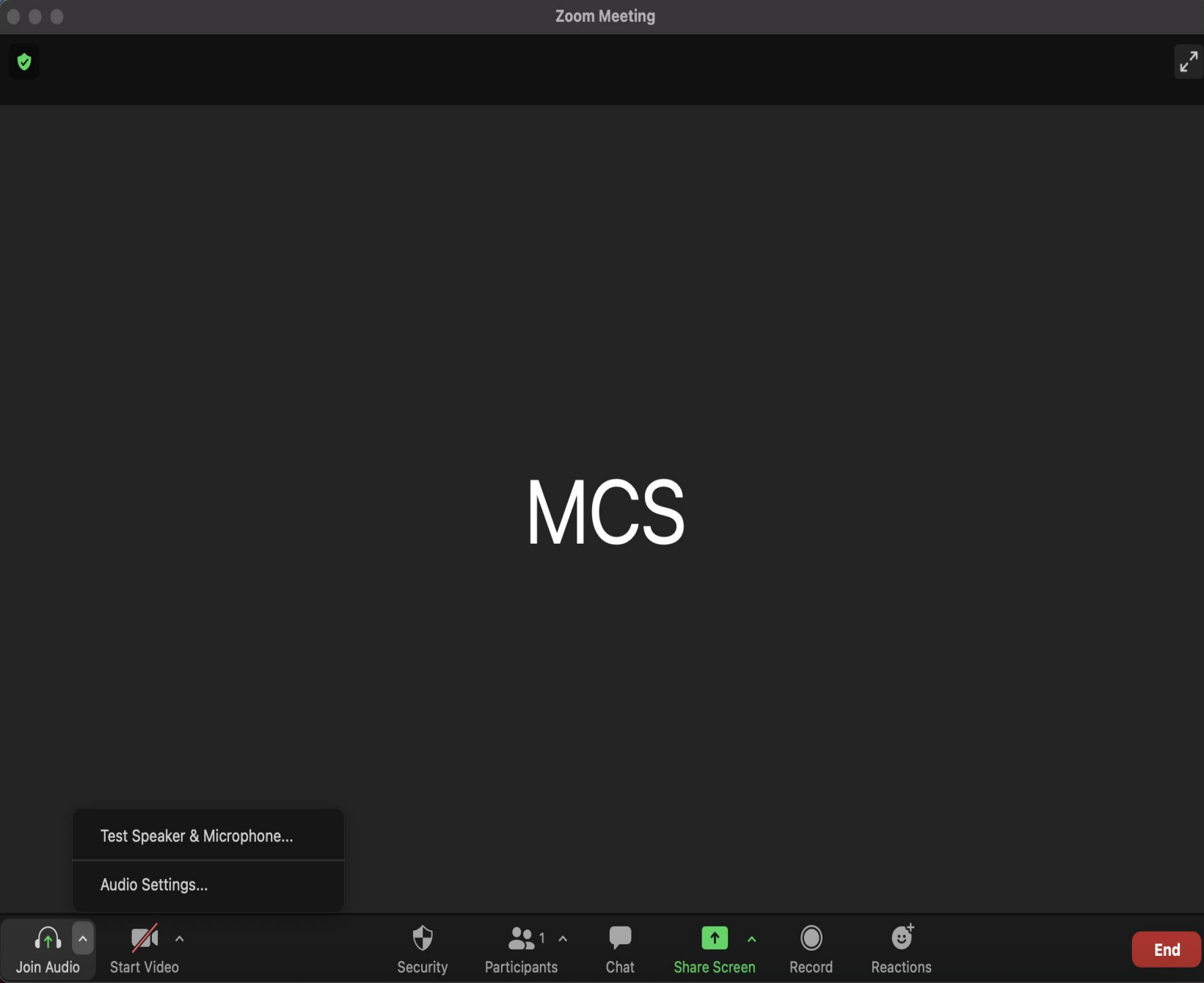

- When you Join your Zoom call your screen will look like this. Note in the bottom left corner is where you can find the controls and settings for the video and audio.

- Clicking on the Audio Icon itself will simply turn on the default Audio source for the Computer.
- Clicking the Arrow in the righthand corner of the audio icon will open the menu for the audio settings and if you have multiple Microphones hooked up to your computer ,you will be able to choose which audio source will be turned on.
